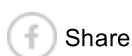

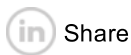

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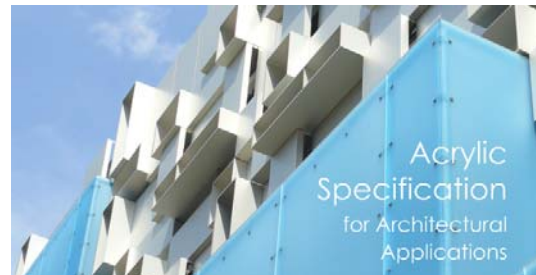

In recognition of the July 4th holiday, LuciteLux® displayed the 'Statue of Liberty' during GlobalShop 2015 Expo in New York City. The statue was designed and manufactured by **Orange County Industrial Plastics** in Anaheim, CA a partner of LuciteLux®. The statue was made out of LuciteLux® Glacier Green part of the LuciteLux® **Frost range**, there were 362 layers of material .118 thick. It took 1 hour and 15 minutes to laser and assembly time took 10 hours. Each layer was numbered in the pattern and assembled by number using weld on #3.
